

Damco sustainability requirements for suppliers

Damco wants to ensure that the services provided to our customers satisfy our social and environmental standards.



All suppliers must acknowledge our Code of Conduct

All suppliers to Damco shall acknowledge and comply with the Damco Code of Conduct



High risk suppliers must undergo due diligence

Suppliers in high risk categories will be assessed for compliance through questionnaires and document review. As necessary, physical audits will be conducted.

High risk categories include: Trucking services, Warehouse & Distribution, Contract Labour, Customs Brokerage services, Promotional goods, Security guard services



Non-compliant suppliers have to improve

Any gaps in relation to the Damco Code of Conduct are discussed and mapped in an Improvement Plan. The supplier is expected to close the gaps within 3 - 6 months by providing evidence for the same.



Follow-up

Damco will arrange a follow-up assessment after six months to verify the improvements and close the gaps.



Good for two years

The initial assessment holds good for 2 years. Post which the suppliers will be reassessed.
